Implementation Authority: On behalf of IEHE, the Director and on behalf of MLB College, the Principal shall act as the implementing authorities, for operating the various provisions of this MOU on behalf of their respective organizations. All formal communications shall be exchanged only through the representatives nominated by each party.

General Terms of Agreements:

- Both the parties agree that no action/ failure on the part of either party to act in relation to the above MOU will give rise to serve as the basis for any claim, obligation or liability on either side.
- The courses offered by IEHE could vary or strengthened/ amended from time to time as mutually agreed and new courses could be added in consultation between the two parties.

Validity of this MOU:

This MOU is valid initially for a period of 36 months starting from the date of signing and can be renewed for a further period on mutually acceptable terms & conditions.

Confidentiality:

In the course of fulfilling the mutual responsibilities under this MOU, there shall be a sharing of information of confidential nature. Both parties hereby agree to

Atal Bihari Institute of Good Governance & Policy Analysis (AIGGPA), Bhopal to be represented by its CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER (CEO), AIGGPA (hereinafter referred to as "AIGGPA"), which expression shall unless repugnant to the context include its successors, representatives and permitted assigns OF THE FIRST PART.

About Institute for Excellence in Higher Education, Bhopal

Institute for Excellence in Higher Education (IEHE), Bhopal to be represented by its Director, IEHE (hereinafter referred to as "IEHE"), which expression shall unless repugnant to the context include its successors, representatives and permitted assigns OF THE SECOND PART.

AIGGPA and IEHE are hereinafter collectively referred to as "Parties" and individually as "Party".)

A. Objectives and Modes of Collaboration

- 1. The goal of this Memorandum of Understanding is to foster collaboration, and provide opportunity for professional, scholarly and academic interaction in matters relating to Public Policy, Governance, Administration and related areas, and to facilitate advancement of knowledge in these areas, based on reciprocity and mutual benefit. AIGGPA and IEHE agree to explore the possibility of engaging in the following modes of collaboration:
- 2. Holding collaborative programmes in the form of lectures, seminars, workshops, panel discussions, symposia, webinars, training programmes and the like in Public Policy, Governance, Administration and related areas.
- Extending cooperation to each other in the areas of teaching, research, publication and other activities associated with Public Policy, Governance, Administration and related areas.
- 4. Preparation of Background Papers, Compendiums, White Papers, Dossiers, Policy Documents and the like on topical issues related to Public Policy, Governance, Administration and related areas, to be submitted to the Government, which could be of assistance to it, in policy formulation in those areas.
- Publication of Proceedings of jointly-organized Seminars, Conferences, Workshops, Webinars, etc., as well as Background Papers, Compendiums, white papers, dossiers, policy documents and the like, on topical issues related to Public Policy, Governance, Administration and related areas.
- 6. Mutual sharing of infrastructure, resources and expertise in the organization of programmes and activities described above.

 AIGGPA and IEHE agree that the following technical descriptions will guide each proposed activity identified and agreed upon by the two institutions.

B. Collaboration for Research and Development

- The Parties agree to investigate ways of identifying and inviting serving and retired civil servants, academicians, researchers, faculty members and other competent persons from the other institutions to participate in ongoing research or development of programmes of mutual interest.
- Further, the Parties agree to jointly identify and pursue opportunities for formulation and submission of new research project proposals or training programmes for possible funding by government and external agencies, if needed.
- 3. It is foreseen that when a member of either institution visits the other institution on invitation, or as part of such joint research project, or to organize a collaborative programme, such a visit will be subject to the regulations of the other Institution.
- 4. The parties agree to involve the students of IEHE & AIGGPA under apprentices/internships/research associates in various projects arising from time to time.
- 5. The parties also agree of launching of the joint online/offline/hybrid certificate programs on various topics as required from time to time, which can be on sharing model.

C. Exchange of Human Resources

The Parties agree to explore ways of encouraging collaboration between researchers/faculty members from the two institutions. Specifically, the two institutions would identify appropriate researchers/faculty members as Principal Investigator(s)/Principal Co- Investigator(s) at their respective ends, and encourage members of their researchers/faculty to undertake short visits for lectures, facilitate research projects at either end, etc. The terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment, including those concerning stipend, travel, and housing, would be worked out between the partner institutions. The resource sharing of the reading/training materials at library can also be accessed mutually among the parties.

D. Intellectual Property

AIGGPA and IEHE agree to respect each other's rights to Intellectual Property (IP). All background IP used in connection with this MoU shall remain the property of the Party that introduces it. No license is granted to any Party to use another Party's Background IP, unless specifically agreed to in writing. Further, the IP rights that arise as a result of any collaborative research or joint activity under this MoU would be subject to separate written agreement/s on the ownership and management of such IP, and each Party agrees to respect the ownership of IP of the other Parties in all dealings, consistent with officially laid down IPR policies of the partner institutions.

No Party to this Memorandum shall use the name, logo or any other designation of any of the other Parties without prior written consent.

E. Tenure and Termination

This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for a period of five years. This MoU will be reviewed after 30 months; the terms of this MoU may be held rigid till the first review. Any extension to this MoU will be formally agreed to, in writing, by the Parties.

Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other Institution, six months in advance. Once terminated, neither Party will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other Institution may suffer. However, AIGGPA and IEHE will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully.

F. Arbitration

Any issues that are not addressed or stipulated in the MoU shall be discussed and resolved through negotiation in good faith and such resolution will be incorporated as written amendments to the MoU by mutual agreement between two Parties.

No disputes are foreseen in the implementation of the MoU. The two Parties, however, agree that if any dispute arises between them, efforts will be made to settle the same as amicably as possible. If the dispute still remains unsettled, it will be referred for resolution bilaterally to CEO, AIGGPA and Director, IEHE. The decisions so arrived at shall be final and binding on the parties to this MoU.

The prime objectives of the BSSS IAS Institute are Teaching, Research, Consultancy and Training and the Institute is seeking alliance with Institutions of repute for collaborative network and enhance the working areas.

The PARTIES agree that, in the event of research collaboration leading to patent rights, copyrights and other intellectual property rights, a further separate written agreement must be entered into in each case in accordance with the policies of 'IEHE, Bhopal 'and the 'BSSS-IAS' on intellectual property.

C. ACTIVITY EXCHANGE PROGRAMME

To facilitate academic and cultural interchange, the exchange of research materials, publications and information between the PARTIES will be encouraged. Each PARTY will invite the other, when appropriate, to participate in conferences, symposia and short visits.

D. TRAINING PROGRAMMES

To enhance the skill knowledge among the Executives through training, both the parties agree to jointly conduct Executive Development Programmes by sharing the faculty and other resources on mutually agreed terms.

E. PECUNIARY INTEREST

The pecuniary interest will be decided mutually, based on programme needs, requirements and each PARTY engagements.

F. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS

Both PARTIES will comply with all relevant laws in the jurisdiction in which it is situated in and all visiting scholars and faculty shall comply with all relevant laws in the jurisdiction of Bhopal only.

G. COMPLIANCE WITH COLLEGE RULES

Visiting party will comply with the rules of the host Institution.

H. NO AGENCY

Nothing in this MOU gives rise to a relationship of agency between the parties.

I. NO JOINT VENTURE, PARTNERSHIP OR EMPLOYMENT RELATIONSHIP

Nothing in this MOU shall be relied upon to construe a joint venture, partnership or employment relationship between the Parties.

J. TERMS OF RENEWAL, AMENDMENT, AND TERMINATION

This MOU shall remain in force for a period of **THREE years** from the execution date at the beginning of this MOU, with the understanding that it may be terminated by either PARTY, giving three months' notice to the other PARTY in writing. If this agreement is terminated by

- d. This MoU is being signed purely with the intention of academic and scientific cooperation without any financial liabilities.

ARBITRATION VI.

Any issues that are not addressed or stipulated in the MoU shall be discussed and resolved through negotiation in good faith and such resolution will be incorporated as written amendments to the MoU by mutual agreement between two Parties.

No disputes are foreseen in the implementation of the MoU. The two Parties, however, agree that if any dispute arises between them, efforts will be made to settle the same as amicably as possible. If the dispute still remains unsettled, it will be referred for resolution bilaterally to Director, IEHE and Registrar, SUBIS. The decisions so arrived at shall be final and binding on the parties to this MoU.

- f) IEHE, BHOPAL may depute its personnel as visiting faculty/ trainers at SGU to teach impart training on any of the regular Course or specialized topics.
- g) SGU Courses may run at any mutually convenient premises but in no way it would clash with the Skill Development Modules.
- h) IEHE, BHOPAL may seek assistance/guidance of SGU faculty member/s in product/process modification, modernization, troubleshooting, etc.
- i) Would allow the industrial visits of students for half/full day to provide them with an exposure to various equipment, instruments, etc. at the IEHE, BHOPAL. or any other premises earmarked for this.
- j) IEHE, BHOPAL may showcase its business activities at the seminar/workshop/conference,
 etc. at SGU as deemed fit.
- k) IEHE, BHOPAL may avail library, Internet, computational facilities at SGU on mutually agreed terms.
- If the outcome of a project related to product development, process technology and design etc. which involves matters of secrecy and concern with security of the State and the Country, the same will not be allowed for publication/printing in any form such as Electronically/verbal, etc. If the outcome of a project results in an intellectual property, for which rights can be secured, it will be decided on a case to case basis. Similarly, sharing of expenditure in securing such rights and income accrued through royalty etc by the parties under the law will be decided on a case to case basis after mutual consultation.
- m) In any of the activities mentioned above, wherever financial aspects are involved, amount, payment conditions, etc. would be spelt out clearly before starting the activity. The financial proceedings must also be as per mutually agreed norms.

ARTICLE-III: SHARING OF FACILITIES

- a) SGU and IEHE, BHOPAL shall make provisions to share their respective important facilities in order to promote academic and research interaction in the areas of cooperation.
- b) SGU and IEHE, BHOPAL shall permit the sharing of software and other materials and components developed in-house in the areas of cooperation, if permissible within the rules governing the two institutions. c) SGU and IEHE, BHOPAL shall provide access to the library facilities to scientists, members of faculty and students as per the prevailing rules and norms in the respective institutes.

ARTICLE-IV: COORDINATION OF THE PROGRAMME INCLUDING FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

- a) The collaborative program between SGU and IEHE ,BHOPAL shall be coordinated by a coordination committee appointed by the competent Authority Directors of both the Institutes.
- b) Financial arrangements consideration for each specific collaboration will be decided on a case-to-case basis and brought on record in each case after due approval from heads of both the Institutions.

ARTICLE-V: EFFECTIVE DATE AND DURATION OF MOU

- a) This MOU shall be made effective from the date of its approval by Competent Authorities at both ends.
- b) The duration of the MOU shall be for a period of 3 years from the effective date & may be enhanced or reduced based on mutually agreed terms & conditions.
 - c) During its tenancy, the MOU may be extended or terminated by a prior notice of not less than six months by either party. However, termination of the MOU will not in any manner affect the interests of the students/faculty/scientists who have been admitted to pursue a program under the MOU.
 - d) Any clause or article of the MOU may be modified or amended by mutual agreement/ consent of IEHE, BHOPAL and SGU.

ARTICLE-VI: IPR

Rights regarding publications, patents, royalty, ownership of software/design/product developed etc. under the scope of this MOU, shall be decided by the two parties by mutual consent.

ARTICLE-VII: CONFIDENTIALITY

During the tenure of the MOU both SGU and IEHE, BHOPAL will maintain strict confidentiality and prevent disclosure of all the information and data exchanged under the scope of this MOU for any purpose other than in accordance with this MOU.

Both SGU and IEHE, BHOPAL shall bind their respective personnel who come into possession or knowledge of any confidential information not to disclose the same to third parties without

written approval of the disclosing party or use such confidential information for any use other than intended under this agreement or PROJECTS.

Further both SGU and IEHE, BHOPAL shall put in place adequate and reasonable measures to keep and store confidential information secure so as to prevent any unauthorized use.

CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION shall mean any proprietary information, data or facts belonging to PARTIES collectively or severally, disclosed by the disclosing party under this agreement or any subsequent agreement, whether in writing, verbal or electronically, irrespective of the medium in which such information is stored, which is marked confidential or with any other words having similar meaning by the disclosing party, or specifically agreed to be kept confidential by the parties, or declared or identified so by the disclosing party before such disclosure or during the discussions. However confidential information shall not include any data or information which:

- (a) is or becomes publicly available through no fault of the receiving party,
- (b) is already in the rightful possession of the receiving party prior to its receipt of such data or information;
- (c) is independently developed by the receiving party without reference to the confidential information of the disclosing party
- (d) is rightfully obtained by the receiving party from a third party or is in the public domain
- (e) is disclosed with the written consent of the party whose information it is, or
- (f) is disclosed pursuant to court order or other legal compulsion, after providing prior notice to the disclosing party.

ARTICLE-VIII: AMENDMENTS

Any amendment and/or addenda to the AGREEMENT shall be in writing and signed by both the PARTIES hereto and shall only after such execution be deemed to form part of the AGREEMENT and have the effect of modifying the AGREEMENT to the extent required by such amendment or addenda.

ARTICLE-IX: RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES

a) This agreement shall take effect and be construed in accordance with the Laws of India and be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts at Bhopal.

b) The dispute or difference whatsoever arises between PARTIES in relation to or in connection with this AGREEMENT both the parties shall first try to resolve the dispute/difference amicably between themselves, failing which the matter shall be referred to and settled through arbitration. The arbitration proceedings shall be held in accordance with the provision of Indian Arbitration and Reconciliation ACT, 1996. The venue of arbitration shall be Bhopal and Language of arbitration shall be English.

ARTICLE-X: MISCELLANEOUS

- a) The headings and subheadings are inserted for convenience only and shall not affect the construction of this Agreement.
- b) Both SGU and IEHE, BHOPAL shall not, during the term of this Agreement directly or indirectly, solicit or offer employment or engagement to any of the personnel of another party without the prior consent in writing of that other party.
- c) No failure to exercise and no delay in exercising, on the part of a Party, and right, remedy, power or privilege hereunder shall operate as a waiver thereof, nor shall any single or partial exercise of any right, remedy, power or privilege hereunder preclude any other or further exercise thereof or the exercise of any other right, remedy, power or privilege. The rights, remedies, power and privileges herein provided are cumulative and not exclusive of any right, remedies, powers and privileges provided by law.
- d) After this Agreement has been signed, all preceding understandings/negotiations and correspondence pertaining to it shall become null and void.

d. training of IEHE personnel through Continuing Education Programs conducted under the schemes of NABM, Gol

e. Any other appropriate mode of interaction agreed upon between IEHE and MPSBM, Govt. of M.P.

Each of the above modes of interaction will be initiated by entering into a separate agreement between the two parties.

3. FORMS OF RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS

The form of any of the said Research and Development Program (hereinafter referred to as "Research Program") will be subject to a separate Research Agreement entered into by the Parties but may also include the following:

a. In their own existing facilities - The performance of research individually by each Party or concurrently by both Parties in mixed groups at their own facilities with regular exchanges of results.

b. In a separate research and development facility - The performance of research by the technical personnel of both Parties working together in the facilities of one Party or in mixed groups at the facilities supported/sponsored by either Party.

c. **Third parties** - The performance of research by the Parties together with one or more third parties.

4. TECHNICAL AREAS OF COLLABORATION

The principal technical areas of collaboration between Department of Biotechnology, IEHE and MPSBM, Govt. of MP will be in the fields of Bamboo related Biotechnology and allied fields.

5. AGREEMENTS FOR RESEARCH COLLABORATION

Each research collaboration undertaken by the parties hereunder shall be initiated by the signing of a separate research agreement between the parties, which will describe in detail:

- a. the nature, scope and schedule of the research collaboration.
- b. the form of the research collaboration.
- c. the estimated cost of the research collaboration together with the amount of funding, if
 - any, to be received from third parties.
- d. the treatment of intellectual property and data rights, including patents, industrial design registration, copyrights and all other proprietary information (including innovations not patented, designs not registered etc.) which result from the research collaboration or which belong to a party and are used in research collaboration.
- e. other provisions as may be mutually agreed upon, including provisions covering the consequences of default or termination by a participant, term, arbitration of disputes and applicable law.

6. CONFIDENTIALITY

- a. During and for a period of three years from the date of disclosure, each party agrees to consider as confidential all information disclosed by the other party in written or tangible form or, if orally disclosed confirmed in writing within thirty days of disclosure and identified as confidential by the disclosing party.
- b. The obligations above shall not extend to any confidential information for which the receiving party can prove that this information is:
 - in the public domain at the time of disclosure or comes within the public domain without fault of the receiving party.
 - already known or become known to the receiving party
 - received from a third party having no obligations of confidentiality to the disclosing
 - independently developed by the receiving party; or
 - required to be disclosed by law or court order.

7. NON-EXCLUSIVITY

The relationship of the parties under this MOU shall be nonexclusive and both parties, including their affiliates, subsidiaries and divisions, are free to pursue other agreements or collaborations of any kind. However, when entering into a particular research agreement, the participants may agree to limit each party's right to collaborate with others on that subject.

8. TERMS AND TERMINATION

This MOU, unless extended by mutual written agreement of the parties, shall expire in three years after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph. This MOU may be amended or terminated earlier by mutual written agreement of the parties at any time. Either party shall have the right to unilaterally terminate this MOU upon 60 days prior written notice to the other party. However, no such early termination of this MOU, whether mutual or unilateral, shall affect the obligations of the participants under any Research Agreement, Confidentiality clause as referenced in clause 6 above, or any other agreement entered into pursuant to this MOU, which obligations shall survive any such termination.

9. RELATIONSHIP

Nothing in this MOU shall be construed to make either party a partner, an agent or legal representative of the other for any purpose.

10. ASSIGNMENT

It is understood by the Parties herein this MOU is based on the professional competence and expertise of each party and hence neither Party shall transfer or assign this Agreement, or rights or obligations arising hereunder, either wholly or in part, to any third party.

11. COSTS OF THE MOU

Each Party shall bear the respective costs of carrying out the obligations under this MOU. There will no financial liability on either party.

12. SIGNED IN DUPLICATE

This MOU is executed in duplicate with each copy being an official version of the Agreement and having equal legal validity.

The Cell has undertaken various prestigious projects and contributed immensely towards appropriate planning, monitoring, documentation, impact assessment analysis and Training programme. The GIS Cell also excels in online and off line Software Development on GIS platform. The centre is constantly engaged in carrying out GIS & Remote Sensing training programme to different officer of corporate sector, NGOs, Technical institutes and students.

Whereas Department of Geography IEHE and NCHSE Bhopal Association shall be hereinafter jointly referred to as the parties.

The IEHE and NCHSE have decided to be in agreement for a 45 days (2hrs. per day) training programme on GIS Application and Operations with mutual interest and in accordance with terms and conditions set in this MoU. IEHE and NCHSE Bhopal agree on the following set of activities:

- 1. NCHSE will provide 45 days training programme to students of Department of Geography of IEHE. Per day 2 hours after college 5:00 to 7:00 p.m.

- 5. The Department of Geography, IEHE shall ensure about the number of participants that would be not less than 10 in numbers in one session. However, the reasonable number of participants is expected to the extent of 20.
- 6. All the trainees from Department of Geography, IEHE should bring their laptops.
- 7. The proposed training programme will be covered in theory as well as by practical's and illustrations through case studies.
- 8. NCHSE shall charge @ Rs. 8000/- per student as fee of complete 45 days training programme which is inclusive of registration, field visit and taxes as per statutory provisions.
- 9. After completion of 45 days Certificate Training Programme on GIS Application and Operations, a written examination will be conducted and Certificate will be given only to successful candidates.
- 10. NCHSE shall be liable to collect the fee of each and every participant in the beginning of the commencement of the training programme.
- 11. NCHSE, will pay 10% of at total amount to the IEHE from the fee collected as administrative expenditure.

This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by the respective representatives of the Parties. It will remain valid for one years. 


