

#### Vocational Course-Handwriting Identification and Recognition

#### About the course:

Forensic handwriting examination is the comparison of two similar types of writing to determine authorship. The main objective of forensic handwriting examination is to analyze, compare and evaluate the handwriting characteristics to determine if the handwriting was or was not prepared by the known writer. In many civil and criminal cases examination of handwriting become crucial and challenging part of the investigation. Thus, "Handwriting Identification and Recognition" is a specialized Vocational Course designed by the Department of Forensic Science, IEHE, Bhopal (M.P.) under NEP 2020 scheme. It is a 04 (01 theory + 3 Practical) credits course especially intended to enhance the professional skills in Handwriting Identification and Recognition. To study this course, a student must have passed class 1st Year in science or any stream.

#### **Course Learning Outcomes:**


After completing this course the student will be able to-
