#### AN INNOVATION IN ASSIGNMENT

The department always have an innovative way of learning. This year 120 students of B.Sc. II chemistry (Hon) performed an assignment on Food Quality and Safety on the theme "Salt Analysis" in the month of September 2018. The students were divided into five groups. Students of M.Sc.(Prev) were the mentors. These five groups performed various activities —

Awareness survey - All the students surveyed about the awareness of the salt consumption among the people in daily life.

Data processing and statistical analysis - This group of students analyzed the data from the survey conducted by the students.

Demonstration This group of students demonstrated iodized salt kit (provided by MPCST) in the other departments of the institute.

Chemical Analysis This group of students conducted experiments with Flame Photometer on various food entities such as pulses, salts, milk and fruits. This experiment is done to find out the Na

and K content in these food items.

Poster and PPT presentation This group of students prepared posters and PPTs on the survey and experimental results.

Skit This group of students presented the issues associated with salt intake in the Chemfotech 2018.


