 - Exploring the possibility to graduate with Double Major under recent NEP guidelines of UGC to ii. make it more effective as it offers more career choices.
 - Multidisciplinary courses, Value Added Courses were also discussed by IQAC Co-ordinator.

- vi. Higher Education Governance Screening Card Scheme under World Bank to be revived and utilized as a tool for self assessment.
- vii. Number of trainings for class III & IV Employees to be increased.
- viii. Dr. Hundet proposed designing of IEHEs memento for felicitating subject expert & invitees after thorough discussion with all the stakeholders.
- ix. All faculty members are empowered to organize 30 hours online certificate courses related to skill development of students.
- x. Research scholars to be given more incentives for excellent work.
- xi. 'Online Teachers' Daily Diary' has become functional from the previous session, it is to be updated as per the convenience of teachers.
- 3. Dr. Pragyesh Kumar Agrawal (Director) appreciated the action plan of IQAC 2023-24, which is prepared after thorough discussions among all the IQAC members.
 - Director Sir spoke about the ongoing NAAC preparation in the Institute for the forthcoming NAAC peer team visit (19th & 20th July 2023).
